I, Keith McNally, declare as follows:

- 1. I am over 18 years of age and competent to testify. I am the President of Ameranth, Inc. ("Ameranth"), the plaintiff in this action, and am one of its original founders. I am also the lead inventor of the four patents-in-suit owned by Ameranth and asserted in the consolidated lawsuits pending before this Court (the '850, '325, '733 and '077 patents). I was involved with the prosecution of the patents in the USPTO. On these bases, I have first-hand personal knowledge of the facts contained in this declaration, and if called upon to testify I would and could do so competently as set forth herein. I provide this declaration in support of Ameranth's Motion to Disqualify Counsel.
- 2. In 2007, Ameranth filed a patent infringement lawsuit on its '850, '325 and '733 patents against Menusoft Corporation ("Menusoft") and other defendants in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Texas, Case No. 2:07-cv-271.
- 3. Menusoft's counsel in the *Ameranth v. Menusoft* lawsuit was the law firm of Fulbright & Jaworski. Attorneys Richard Zembek, Mark Delflache and Dustin Mauck were some of the Fulbright attorneys chiefly involved with that matter.
- 4. The judicial officer presiding over the *Ameranth v. Menusoft* case was the Honorable Chad Everingham. Among other things, Judge Everingham presided over a motion for summary judgment, the claim construction hearing, the trial, and settlement conferences held with the parties in an attempt to resolve the dispute. The case was tried before Judge Everingham from September 13-20, 2010. Jim Warriner was Judge Everingham's law clerk at the time.
- 5. On September 15, 2010, Judge Everingham met separately with representatives of both Ameranth and Menusoft in his chambers to attempt to settle

the parties' dispute short of trial. Both I and Vern Yates of Ameranth attended the meeting with Judge Everingham. Mr. Yates and I shared sensitive and confidential information with Judge Everingham during the settlement conference meeting about Ameranth, its patents and litigation and licensing strategies that was not made public or shared with Menusoft or other defendants, including Ameranth's assessment of the merits of its case, the strength and scope of its patents, and its licensing goals and strategies. We were made to understand that our discussions with Judge Everingham were to be treated confidentially.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States that the foregoing is true and correct of my own personal knowledge and that this declaration was executed by me in San Diego, California, on November 20, 2013.
